STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. To induce vomiting, give warm (one or two glasses of) water and touch the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluids clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If inhaled: Remove victim to a well-ventilated area with good air flow. If in eyes: Flush with water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician immediately. If on skin: Wash with soap and water. If on clothing: Remove clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. If in eyes: Flush with water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Endosulfan is a central nervous system stimulant and may cause convulsions. There is no specific antidote. Supportive therapy is indicated.
