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Subject: Amended Labeling - Additional Precautions for Livestock Spraying Py-Vona Stock Fly Spray EPA Registration No. 1386-418 Your Amended Application Dated November 7, 1986

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Pederal Insectici.e, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipsent bearing the amended labeling:

1. Add the following Environmental Hazard statement to labeling:

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from animals being treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

2. Revise the eye treatment to read:

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if frritation persists.

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4. Delete "During commercial or prolonged exposure . . . " and replace with the following: "During space spraying indoors-mixingloading operations . . . etc."

5. Add the following to the "Barn Spraying" directions:

When used in enclosed areas do not remain in treated areas after spraying. Ventilate the area before reentering.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

sear of base. It is a ready-to-use spray for application directly to dairy cattle, beef cattle, hogs, sheep, goats, and horses to control house flies, horn flies, stable flies, and mosquitoes and to aid in control of face flies.

DIRECT SPRAYING OF LIVSTOCK—Apply as a finely atomized spray uniformly distributed over each animal at a rate of 1 to 2 fluid ounces per animal on dairy cattle, beef cattle, and horses, and at a rate of 1 fluid ounce per animal on hogs, sheep and goats. Reduce application rate by one-half for young animals. Use good spray equipment to spray each animal, preferably from the rear, directing the spray along both sides, including the belly, flanks, and withers, down each leg, over the back and around the poll. Hold nozzle of sprayer 2 or 3 feet away from the animal, so as to deposit droplets on the hair. DO NOT WET THE HIDE. For milking dairy animals, apply the spray 20 to 30 minutes before beginning to milk, or after milking has been completed. DO NOT SPRAY UDDERS OF LACTATING DAIRY ANIMALS. DO NOT APPLY IN EXCESS OF RATES STATED PER ANIMAL. Repeat daily as needed. Do not apply regularly to calves under six months of age. Brahman cattle should not be treated as they may show hypersensitivity to organic phosphates. Do not treat animals within one day of slaughter. Do not apply dermally in combination with Trichlorfon.

BARN SPRAYING—To control house flies in dairy barns, milk rooms, loafing sheds, livestock barns, stables, and poultry houses, apply 2 fluig ounces per 1,000 cubic feet as a finely atomized spray, uniformly distributed throughout the area. To reduce air movement as much as possible, it is preferable to close windows and doors before spraying; leave them closed for 10 minutes after spraying and then ventilate the area. Repeat daily, morning and afternoon, as needed. Do not apply as a barn spray it animals which have received direct application within 8 hours remain in the barn.

DO NOT CONTAMINATE FEED, DRINKING WATER, MILK, AND MILKING EQUIPMENT.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Use only a fine spray mist at a distance of 2 - 3 feet as directed to deposit a light mist on the hair. Do not apply when animals are lathered or temperatures exceed 80° F.
