DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TOMATOES—To control early blight, late blight, Septoria leaf spot, gray leaf spot, and anthracnose on field grown tomatoes, apply uniformly and thoroughly to foliage and fruit at the rate of 30 to 40 pounds per acre. Begin applications before diseases appear, or when disease is first reported in the area, and repeat the 7 to 10-day intervals or oftener under severe disease conditions.

POTATOES—To control early blight and late blight, apply thoroughly to the foliage at the rate of 40 to 50 pounds per acre. Begin applications when plants are small (2 to 4 inches high), and repeat at 5 to 10-day intervals as long as blight conditions persist. Under severe disease conditions, use the shorter interval between applications.

CUCUMBERS, MELONS, AND SQUASH—To control downy mildew and anthracnose, apply thoroughly and uniformly at the rate of 30 to 40 pounds per acre. Begin applications when the runners start to form, or when disease is first reported in the area, and repeat at 7 to 10-day intervals. Under severe disease conditions, apply at 3 to 5-day intervals.
