To protect dairy cattle and beef cattle against horn flies, and to aid in reducing face flies, use this solution undiluted to saturate

fabric covering of back rubber device or to fit applicator. The device or applicator should be cleaned and can readily rub against it several times daily. Apply solution over portions of their hide. It is preferred to use device or applicator in gateways, entrances, and pastures to water or salt so the cattle will be going from one area to another.

To control face flies, use undiluted solution with applicator designed to apply the oil solution to the face when cattle push against it to have a

Do not apply to calves under 6 months of age. Should not be treated as they may show hypersensitivity to phosphates.
