

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Cover fish bowls, exposed food, and utensils before spraying and until treated area is thoroughly ventilated.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to any body of water.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate can. Do not store or leave in location where temperature may exceed 120° F.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE SHAKE BEFORE USING

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO USE—Remove protective cap from top of can. Hold can upright. Point valve opening away from face. Press down lightly on valve top to release spray. Keep fingers away from spray. Keep nozzle 18 inches away from surfaces being sprayed. Do not spray directly onto plastic materials, asphalt tile, asphalt siding, and synthetic rubber products. Replace cap when not in use to protect valve. When container is nearly empty, shake it from side to side while holding it upright to discharge remainder of contents.

INSECTS IN THE HOUSE

Flying Insects

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS, HORNETS, GNATS, AND FLYING MOTHS—Close doors and windows. Spray upward with slow, swooping motion, keeping direct discharge of spray at least 18 inches away from walls, furniture, and fabrics, for 8 to 10 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet. Keep room closed for 10 minutes or longer. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the areas after treatment is completed. Repeat as necessary.

Crawling Insects

ANTS, BOXELDER BUGS, CENTIPEDES, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, GRAIN MITES, ROACHES, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS, AND WATERBUGS—Spray thoroughly wherever insects might be hiding such as along baseboards, moldings, seams, crevices, under and behind sink, cupboards, cabinets, refrigerator, around pipes, and drains and door sills and window frames where the insects may enter. When driven out of hiding, spray directly onto the insects. Repeat as necessary.

BEDBUGS AND FLEAS—Spray floor coverings, floors, mattresses (particularly seams and tufts, on both top and bottom), bed frame, and sleeping quarters of pets. Replace old bedding used by pets. Repeat as necessary. Treated mattress should be aired and dried for 4 hours before reuse.

INSECTS IN THE GARDEN

(Ornamental Flowers and Shrubs)

ANTS (PAVEMENT), APHIDS, ARMYWORMS, CATERPILLARS (ACCESSIBLE), CLOVER MITES, JAPANESE BEETLE ADULTS, LACE BUGS, LEAFHOPPERS, ROSE CHAFER, SPIDER MITES, THRIPS (EXPOSED), AND WHITE FLIES—Direct spray with slow, sweeping motion over plants so the mist reaches underneath foliage, holding can 18 inches away from plants. Spray lightly to avoid wetting leaves. Apply when air is calm. Spray at rate of 1 foot per second, or in short bursts so that spray drifts into the plants. If growth is dense, spray from both sides. Apply with caution on tender foliage, new growth, and young plants. Protects ornamental flower plants and shrubs such as:

Asters	Deciduous	Kentia Palms
Azaleas	Shrubs	Laurels
Begonias	Delphiniums	Mangolds
Camelias	Dogwood	Petunias
Carnations	Evergreens	Rhododendrons
Chrysanthemums	Gladiolas	Roses
Dahlias	Grape Vines	Salvia

Indoor or House plants, such as African Violet, ivy, rubber plants, and Sansevieria may be sprayed as described above. Do not spray plants when temperature exceeds 90°F. Do not use on Kantaria and Maiden hair fern.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store upright in a cool, locked storage area.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
