EPA has determined that **this product does not fall within the scope of PR Notice 93-7**. The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is accepted. A copy of the stamped "Accepted" label is enclosed.

WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. Any other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application but not directly related to compliance with the WPS have not been reviewed or accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. If your product is currently suspended, the acceptance of this labeling amendment does not affect the suspension in any way.



May be harmful if swallowed. May cause irritation of nose and throat of some individuals. Avoid inhalation of dust. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Give victim one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If Inhaled:** remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated. **If on Skin:** wash with soap and water. **If in Eyes:** flush with water for at least 15 minutes. Contact a physician.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, potholes). Runoff and drift from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in adjacent sites. Do not apply to crops or areas other than those for which directions are stated in this label. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift of dust from area treated. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To control the insects on the crops listed below, apply 1 pound of dust per 1,000 square feet or 1 pound per 1,000 linear feet of row (40-45 pounds of dust per acre), using a mechanical applicator or duster to effect uniformly thorough coverage of the foliage, particularly the underside of the leaves:

BEANS—Mexican bean beetle and bean leaf beetle.

PEAS—Pea aphid.

CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER, and BROCCOLI—Imported cabbage worm and flea beetles.

CUCUMBER, MELONS, and SQUASH—Cucumber beetles (striped and spotted).

TOMATO, POTATO, PEPPERS, and EGGPLANT—Flea beetles and aphids.

ASPARAGUS—Asparagus beetle.

RASPBERRIES—Raspberry fruitworm.

Begin applications when the insects first appear, or before damage is noticeable, and repeat at 5 to 7-day intervals as necessary through the growing season.

DO NOT APPLY TO THE ABOVE NAMED CROPS WITHIN 1 DAY OF HARVEST.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store product in original container and in a locked storage area. Do not store with or near feed or food products.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty bag. Discard bag in trash.
