

severe injury to nearby plants. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift. Do not apply to the soil in areas where the roots of desirable trees or ornamental plants may extend, or in locations where the chemical may be washed into contact with their roots. Do not apply within the drip line of trees and shrubs. Do not clean application equipment in these areas.

Do not graze or feed or sell for feeding to livestock and poultry any foliage from treated areas. Keep children and pets off treated areas until the herbicide has been washed into the soil by adequate rainfall and weed foliage has completely dried. If tall vegetation is treated, remove when dead to reduce hazard from fire.

Application equipment and utensils used to apply this herbicide should not be used subsequently for applying insecticides, fungicides, selective herbicides, and fertilizers, since it is almost impossible to clean such equipment adequately to prevent injury to desirable plants. Thoroughly clean and dry mechanical equipment after each use, however, to reduce corrosion.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

USE THIS PRODUCT ONLY IN OR ON AREAS WHERE ALL PLANT GROWTH MAY BE PREVENTED FOR SEVERAL WEEKS TO AN ENTIRE GROWING SEASON. DO NOT USE ON OR NEAR DESIRABLE PLANTS OR CROPS, OR ON THE SOIL IN WHICH DESIRABLE PLANTS ARE GROWING OR ARE TO BE GROWN.

APPLICATION To control most annual and shallow-rooted weeds and grasses, this product undiluted may be applied as a spray, or it may be mixed with water and the diluted mixture applied as a spray or with a sprinkling can.

The best time to apply is before weed seeds germinate or soon after weed emergence when the weeds are in a rapidly-growing succulent condition and are not over 2 to 4 inches tall. If unwanted vegetation is more than 4 inches high, cut or mow to a height of about 2 inches, remove cut vegetation, and apply the spray to the remaining stubble and soil.

Although "burning" of plant foliage may be evident within a few days after application, this product acts primarily through the roots and therefore, sufficient rainfall to move the chemical into the root zone in the soil is necessary, and actual killing of weeds may require 2 to 3 weeks after adequate rainfall has occurred. Under conditions of frequently heavy rainfall or if the growing season is long, a second application may be necessary to maintain seasonal control of weed.

RATES To control annual weeds and grasses on walks, driveways, patios, clay tennis courts, and parking lots, apply 1 quart of undiluted product per 100 square feet 10'x10' of area to be treated. The spray should be applied uniformly and thoroughly to the area.

For firelanes, fence rows, and similar non-productive areas where vegetation is not desired, dilute or mix 1 quart of product in 1 gallon of water and apply the total quantity of mixture to 100 square feet of area. The application may be made with a sprayer or with a sprinkling can to effect uniform distribution and thorough coverage of the weed foliage and the soil. A second application may be required in 2 months to suppress deep-rooted perennial weeds such as Canada thistle and milkweed.

For spot treatments on driveways, walks, and patios, apply the undiluted product to areas as weeds are noticed, as a coarse wetting spray.

LIMITATIONS Considerable caution must be exercised in using this material to avoid injury to crops and desirable plants. Keep the spray away from flower beds, lawns, shrubs, and other desirable vegetation. Apply only when there is no hazard from drift of spray from the area treated, since even minute quantities may cause
