The labeling referred to above, cubaitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Add the following "Statement of Practical Treatment."

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything

by mouth to an unconscious person.

Remove victim to fresh air. IF INHALED:

Apply artificial respiration if

indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and

water.

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IF IM EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

HOTE TO PHYSICIAM: Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM
is also antidotal and may be
administered in conjunction
with atropine.

2. Under "Precautionary Statement" add the following statement:

During space apraying indoors, mixing and loading operators must wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration (formerly the U.S. Bureau of Mines) and by the Mational Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11.

3. Under "Barn Spraying" add the following:

When used in enclosed areas do not remain in treated areas after spraying. Ventilate the area before reentering.

4. Include "petroleum distillates" in the total percentage of inert ingredients since it is not active in this formulation. Since it can present an aspiration hazard if ingested, add the phrase "Contains petroleum distillates" immediately beneath the ingredient statement. Asterisk this phrase to Inert Ingredients.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

It is a ready-to-use spray for application directly to lactating dairy cattle and beef cattle to control housefiles, horn files, stable files and mosquitoes, and to ald in control of face files. Also may be used as a barn spray to control housefiles.

DIRECT SPRAYING OF LIVESTOCK—Apply as a finely atomized mist uniformly distributed over each animal (dairy cattle and beef cattle) at a rate not to exceed 2 fluid ounces daily per animal. Use good spray equipment to spray each animal, preferably from the rear, directing the spray along both sides, including the belly, flanks and withers, down each ag, over the back and around the poll so that droplets are deposited on the face. Hold nozzle of sprayer 2 to 3 feet away from animal so as to deposit droplets on the hair. DO NOT WET THE HIDE. Repeat daily as needed. For milking dairy animals, apply the spray 20 to 30 minutes before beginning to milk or after milking has been completed.

Repeat daily, morning and afternoon, as needed. Do not apply as a barn spray if animals which have received direct application within 8 hours remain in the barn; remove such animals before spraying.
