DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use UNICO Lawn Bug Blaster to control chinch bugs, sod webworms (lawn moths), earwigs, cutworms, grasshoppers, ants, brown dog tick and crickets infesting home lawns and ornamental turf areas. Mix UNICO Lawn Bug Blaster with water according to directions given in following table and apply as a coarse (large droplets) spray using a low pressure sprayer such as a knapsack type, hose attached applicator or other similar equipment. For best results the lawn should be moist at time of application and care should be taken to obtain complete and uniform coverage of pest infested areas. Spray when pests first appear, retreat when needed. One application usually will control chinch bugs for up to 8 weeks.
