SUBJECT: Label Amendment Submission of 08/11/93 in Response to PR Notice 93-7 EPA Reg. No. 1386-627 RED PANTHER DURSBAN GRANULAR TURF AND LAWN INSECTICIDE

Dear Registrant:

The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, successfully **REMOVES THE PRODUCT FROM THE SCOPE** of PR Notice 93-7 once the comments (if any) on the attached sheet are addressed. Other than the alterations (if any) listed on the attached sheet, no further alterations to the labeling are necessary to reflect the requirements of the Worker Protection Standard.

Since your amendment proposes to delete uses directly and/or to delete uses implicitly through the use of exclusionary statements, the Agency will publish in the Federal Register a notice of receipt of your amendment to delete uses, as required by section 6(f)(1) of FIFRA. The Agency will defer action for 90 days from the date of the Federal Register notice to give affected minor users an opportunity to try to persuade you to retain the uses(s). When the comment period has expired, the Agency will approve the amendment unless you have withdrawn it, and stamp the amended labeling "accepted." Your stamped-accepted labeling will then be sent to you.

As described in Supplement A of PR Notice 93-11 (self-verification option), you may sell and distribute product bearing the submitted labeling before you receive a copy of your stamped-accepted labeling. Note that your registration is not amended until the comment period required by section 6(f)(1) of FIFRA has expired and the Agency has approved the amendment. Therefore, you may withdraw your proposed amendment at any time during the comment period and until you receive your stamped-accepted labeling.

#### TURF AND LAWNS

Not for use on turf being grown (1) for sale or other commercial use as sod, or (2) for commercial seed production, or (3) for research purposes.

Apply Red Panther Dursban Granules insecticide uniformly to home lawns and Apply Red Panther Dursban Granules insecticide uniformly to home lawns and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas using any hand or power oper-ated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear using Red Panther Dursban Granules at the rate of 200 pounds per acre. To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction; then apply the balance at a right angle. Immediately after application sprinkle the turf with 1300 gallons of water per acre so as to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Consult the following table to determine amounts of Red Panther Dursban Granules and water needed for smaller sized areas. Re-treat as necessary.

To control certain white grubs (larvae of European chafer and Japanese beetle) use To control certain white grubs (larvae of European chaier and Japanese beetle) use two to four times the amounts of Red Panther Dursban Granules shown in the table, i.e. 10 to 20 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. Apply the granules uniformly over the area treated followed immediately by thorough watering to wash the insecticide into the turf. For best results treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultu-ral Extension Service specialis' for proper time to treat in your ares. To control Hyperodes (turfgrass) weevils use twice the rate of Red Panther Durs-ban Granules shown in the table. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-Max. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for

again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for best time to treat in your area.
