Apply Security Pro-Turf 1 Insect Control Granules to turf grass areas uniformly using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary-type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear using this product at the rate of 2 1/2 pounds per 1,000 square feet. The maximum application rate is 1 pound active ingredient per acre. To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one half the required amount of product in one direction; then apply the balance at a right angle. Immediately after application, irrigate or sprinkle the turf with water so as to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Consult the following table to determine the amounts of this product and water required. Retreat as necessary. Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and the turf is dry.
