

PENTACHLOROPHENOL

DIRECTIONS (After Dilution)

DESCRIPTION: 10-1 concentrate wood preservative. For any wood not to be painted, varnished or finished. Protects against decay, termites, carpenter ants, mold, powder post beetles and mildew.

APPLICATION: Use only at 40°F. (4.4°C) surrounding temperatures, or above. Non-commercial users can apply by soak, dip, brush or low pressure flooding spray. Commercial users can use hot-cold soaking, pressure and vacuum processes. Treat after cutting and machining whenever possible. Re-treat newly cut surfaces with several liberal brush applications. For fenceposts and wood to be in contact with soil, wood should be dry and free from outer and inner bark and soaked 24-48 hours vertically with butt ends down. Oil drums welded together make excellent treating tanks.

TERMITE CONTROL: For new construction, treat all new wood with Penta. Immerse lumber less than 1 inch thick for 3 minutes and at least 5 minutes for each additional inch of thickness. Treat soil (see below). For old construction, replace badly eaten wood with Penta-treated wood. Apply Penta by brush or flooding spray to all exposed wood surfaces. All cutting, boring, etc., should be done before treating. Treat soil (see below).

SOIL TREATMENT: For hollow block foundations, dig a trench 30 inches deep, but not below the top of the footing, if it is shallower. Apply Penta at the rate of 5 gal./10 linear feet of trench in trenches up to 15 inches deep, at the rate of 10 gal./10 linear feet in deeper trenches. Grass, trees and shrubs within 3 feet of the trench should be removed or protected with tar paper.

For wood to be painted: Use WOODLIFE paintable water repellent wood preservative.

CLEAN-UP: Use mineral spirits to clean immersion tanks, spray equipment and surrounding area.
