The U.S. EPA has determined that pentachlorophenol can produce defects in the offspring of laboratory animals. Exposure to pentachlorophenol during pregnancy should be avoided.

Avoid breathing vapors. If inhalation of vapors cannot be avoided, applicators must wear a properly fitting, well-maintained full-face respirator with a HEPA filter approved for polynuclear aromatics and organic vapors.

Applicators must wear gloves impermeable to the wood treatment formulation in all situations where contact is expected for mixing, during the actual application process and when handling freshly treated wood.

Spray applicators must wear protective clothing (including overalls, socks, gaiters, boots, and head covering) impermeable to the wood treatment formulation, and a respirator and goggles when spraying.

Applicators who apply pentachlorophenol by other application processes (e.g., spray on, dust, wear long sleeved shirts, long pants and an apron, etc.) must wear clothing separately from other household laundry.

Protective clothing must be changed when it shows signs of contamination. Change non-removable protective clothing separately from other household clothing. Wash all items in protective clothing and work clothes or boots in a separate cycle in the wash, or in any other manner approved for pesticide treatment.

Applicators must not eat, drink, or use tobacco products during those parts of the application process that may expose them to the wood treatment formulation.

Do not apply where there may be direct contact with domestic animals or livestock, and where there may be contamination of food, feed, or drinking and irrigation water.

Do not apply pentachlorophenol to wood intended for farming or breeding facilities.

Do not apply pentachlorophenol to wood intended to be used in the interior of any building where there may be direct contact with children, animals or persons who may be unable to avoid the wood. Pentachlorophenol may be used in these situations if the use of barriers or other suitable means prevents contact with children, animals or persons who may be unable to avoid the wood. If the use of an appropriate barrier will be applied, barriers may be applied at the installation site.

Do not apply to wood intended to be used in a manner in which the product will become a component of food or animal feed. Samples of such sites will be structures or containers for storing silage or food.

Do not use this product to treat wood intended to be used for cutting blocks or similar uses.

Do not use this product to treat wood intended for the construction of those portions of bridges which may come into contact with the water.

Do not use this product to treat wood intended for use where it may come into direct or indirect contact with drinking water from the public and domestic supplies of livestock except for those uses involving incidental contact such as docks and bridges.

Wood to be treated with this product should be cut to size before treatment. It is to be treated with this product and a dust mask to avoid inhaling dust from the treated wood. If any irritations or allergic reactions are noticed, discontinue use immediately. Wash your clothes separately from other household laundry.

Contact with treated surfaces should be avoided even after the preservative has dried. When handling treated wood wear long-sleeved shirts, long pants and protective gloves to your wrists, avoid contact with treated wood and before eating, drinking or using tobacco products.

This product should not be used to treat wood which will be in contact with skin, unless the wood will be treated with an effective sealant.

As used on this label, the term "respirators" means properly fitted and maintained full-face respirators or cartridge respirators which are NIOSH-approved for polynuclear aromatics and organic vapors. Cartridges or canisters must be replaced during application and handling of wood to be treated. Use only HEPA filter respirators. Do not use any other type of respirator.
