

Precautionary Statements: Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Do not get this product on clothing, shoes, or material through skin. Do not get it on face, or skin or in clothing. Keep children and pets away from treated areas. Applicators must wear gloves impermeable to the wood treatment formulation in all situations where direct contact is possible. For example, during the initial application process and when handling treated wood.

Some applicators must wear protective clothing (including overalls, trousers, gaiters, boots, and head covering) approved for the wood treatment formulation, and a respirator and gaiters when spraying.

Applicators who apply pentachlorophenol by other application processes (e.g., brush or wash) must wear long-sleeved shirts, long pants and an impermeable apron. Launder work clothes separately from other household laundry.

Protective clothing must be changed when it shows signs of contamination. Launder non-impervious protective clothing separately from other household clothing. Dispose of non-impervious protective clothing and washes of boots in an impervious container, in the trash, or in any other manner approved for pesticide disposal.

Applicators must not eat, drink, or use tobacco products during these parts of the application process that may expose them to the wood treatment formulation.
