Blue stain is a problem only on fresh cut lumber and treatment must be made within 24 hours of cutting to effectively prevent staining. If the product is to be applied to fresh cut lumber, indicate that treatment must be made within 24 hours of cutting for prevention of blue stain.

c. The labels for the one gallon containers must bear the storage and disposal statements applicable to homeowner use as specified in FR Notice 83-3. The 5 and 55 gallon container labels must bear the appropriate statements specified in the same notice for commercial or industrial use products.

Outstanding Features

WOODLIFE Clear Wood Preservative is a blend of chemicals with the protection of an effective water repellent wood preservative.

WOODLIFE Clear Wood Preservative penetrates into wood and controls the growth of decay fungi (like brown or white rot), staining fungi (like blue stain), and surface mold (like black, brown or other colored mildew). It stabilizes wood against the effects of moisture and reduces dimensional change that can cause swelling, warping and splitting.

Directions for Use

Apply this product only as specified on the label. It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product must be applied out-of-doors to wood intended only for exterior use. (Note to User: Keep container closed when not in use!)

Do not use on wood which will come in continuous contact with the skin unless the wood is sealed with paint, varnish or shellac after treatment.

Preparation

For best results, all cutting, glueing and sanding should be done before applying WOODLIFE Clear Wood Preservative. Wood must be clean, dry, and free from foreign material. This product can be used on unfinished new wood, unfinished weathered wood. Stains and paints should be stripped for best results. Do not use steel wool. If mildew is present, remove by washing with a 50% dilution of household bleach followed by water. If extractive bleeding has occurred, scrub with a diluted solution of oxalic acid (1/4 lb. per gallon of water) and then wash at once with clear water. Always wear rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles when using bleach and oxalic acid. Allow surface to dry before applying.

Application

Stir well before using. No thinning is required. The temperature of the wood and the WOODLIFE Clear Wood Preservative should be 40° F (4.4° C) or above. This product may be applied by roller or brush. When roller coating, use a brush to finish edges and grooves. Be sure to brush thoroughly so that all surfaces are completely wetted and covered. Coat side and end grain with consecutive coats until its thirst for solution has been filled. If two coats are desired, be sure to apply the second coat before the first coat has dried. Any surface cut after treatment should be retreated.

Coverage

100-150 sq. ft./gal. depending on the porosity of the wood.

Drying Time

A minimum of 24-48 hours depending on conditions and method of application. On humid days, longer drying time may be required.

Cleanup

Use Mineral Spirits to remove wet WOODLIFE Clear Wood Preservative from all surfaces, brushes and rollers.
