AA FLY SPRAY

For Use In Homes, Hotels, Institutions

Active Ingredients:

Refined Petroleum Hydrocarbons	99.683%
*Piperonyl butoxide technical	0.281%
Pyrethrins	0.036%
Total Active Ingredients	100.000%
*Equivalent to 0.225% of (butylcarbityl) (6-propylpiperonyl) ether and 0.056% of related compounds.	

DIRECTIONS: For controlling flies, mosquitoes, gnats. Close windows and doors. Fill room with mist. Spray toward ceiling in all directions. Leave room closed for ten or fifteen minutes. It is frequently desirable to sweep up and destroy the fallen insects at the close of the ten minute period. Re-open windows and doors and let fresh air in before occupying.

DIRECTIONS: For Ants—Spray freely and directly on insect if possible. Then spray around baseboards, doors, sills and window frames where pests may enter premises. Repeat applications are required in all instances.

DIRECTIONS: For fleas—Use same directions as for ants. Treat floor and floor coverings. Spray frequently the sleeping quarters of animals.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.
