

PINE ODOR DISINFECTANT

PHENOL COEFFICIENT 5

(A. O. A. C. METHOD)

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Steam Distilled Pine Oil

Isopropanol

Sodium o benzyl p chlorophenol

Potassium Oleate

INERT INGREDIENTS:

Water

65%

DIRECTIONS

For maximum efficiency, clean surface well before applying disinfectant solution.

Put disinfectant in a pail, adding water and stirring. Use warm water when possible.

For general disinfectant against S. Typhosa, apply a solution of 1 part Disinfectant to 100 parts water. Let remain on surface as long as possible for Maximum disinfection.

URINAL AND TOILETS: To be cleaned daily with a solution 1 to 100.

CUSPIDORS — HARD SURFACE AREAS: To be wiped with a 1 to 100 solution. Leave a small amount in sputum receptacles.

GENERAL CLEANING: Pine Odor Disinfectant has an exceptional cleaning action. One teaspoon to a pail of water not only cleans but deodorizes.

-CAUTION-

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Antidote if taken internally: Give milk, white of raw eggs, mucilage or cornstarch, and follow with an emetic such as a tablespoon of mustard in a tumbler of warm water.

Concentrate may cause skin irritation. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.
