

CLEANER and DISINFECTANT

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Potassium Soap 14.0%
Ortho-benzyl-para-chlorophenol 3.5%
Isopropyl alcohol 3.0%

INERT INGREDIENTS: 79.5%

PHENOL COEFFICIENT: A. O. A. C. METHOD S. TYPHOSA 5

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

By following the directions and using the correct dilutions as given, a solution will be obtained that will clean, sanitize and disinfect in one operation. Acts as a deodorizer by its germicidal activity. Always use clean mops, pails and water.

TO USE AS A CLEANER, SANITIZER AND DISINFECTANT: Always allow solution to remain on surface for 3 to 5 minutes and agitate with mop or brush.

FOR USE IN HOTELS, MOTELS, SCHOOLS, SUPERMARKETS, OFFICES, HOMES: Mopping: Use 1½ to 3 oz. per gallon of water. Mop or squeegee dirty solution from floor after 3 to 5 minutes. On extremely dirty surfaces, the use of 4 to 5 oz. to each gallon of water is recommended to insure disinfection.

Spraying: Use 2 to 5 oz. per gallon of water and apply. After 5 minutes, take up with mop or squeegee.

Sponging or Wiping: (Walls, Metal Cabinets, Woodwork) Use 1½ to 3 oz. per gallon of water and apply. Wring out cloth in solution frequently. Wipe with dry cloth. The use of rubber gloves is recommended for this procedure.

FOR USE IN MEAT, POULTRY, FISH AND OTHER FOOD PROCESSING AREAS: Before using, food products and packing materials must be removed from the room, or carefully protected. After using, equipment and utensils must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water. Floors, walls, cabinets must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water after cleaning.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

In case of spillage of this concentrate on skin wash immediately with soap and water. If irritation of the skin is felt when using the suggested dilution for cleaning, wash solution from hands with soap and water and apply a hand lotion or skin cream. May cause skin or eye irritation. If contact with eyes occurs, flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists, get medical attention. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it. Avoid breathing spray mist.
