DIRECTIONS

For use in barns, dwellings, warehouses, food processing plants. Outdoors as an aid in controlling flies, wasps, june bugs, flying moths. Paint or coarse spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames with a solution of 1 part concentrate with 4 parts water. Repeat as needed.

Ants, ^{ANTS} roaches, crickets, spiders, silverfish: Thoroughly treat infested cracks, hiding or resting places, window sills, doorsills, openings around pipes and other openings where insects may enter. Use a 1 to 5 dilution with water or base oil and thoroughly wet with a coarse spray. Repeat as necessary.

As a baited spray: Use one gallon concentrate per each 5 gallons water. Add 5 tablespoons dark sugar or unsulfured molasses. Wet spray around dwellings, barns and garbage heaps.

-CAUTION-
KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.
