PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Wash thoroughly after using and before smoking or eating. Do not allow children to contact treated surfaces until surfaces are completely dry. Do not use as a space spray. Do not use on household pets or humans.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes immediately with water. Remove any contact lenses, then hold eyelids open and flush eyes thoroughly with water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Immediately remove any contaminated clothing (wash before reuse) and wash affected skin with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: If ill or unconscious, remove victim to fresh air. Maintain respiration. Get immediate medical attention.

IF SWALLOWED: For conscious victim rinse mouth with water, spit out rinse and drink a glassful of water. Do not induce vomiting unless directed by medical personnel. Get immediate medical attention. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains over 80% Petroleum Distillates (lung aspiration hazard). Also contains a cholinesterase inhibitor (Atropine Sulfate is antidotal).

PHYSICAL/CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Combustible mixture: Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not smoke while using.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or equipment washwaters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product must be applied using a compressed air sprayer. Do not apply this product using a trigger pump sprayer.

Spray infested surfaces only until wet.

INDOORS

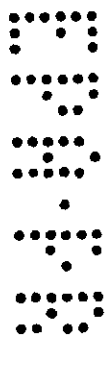
Avoid contamination of food, food processing equipment, and food handling surfaces. Use only in inedible product areas of meat, poultry, and food processing plants. Apply only when plant is not in operation. Remove all food and containers before applying. Cover all processing surfaces and rinse with water before resuming operation. Apply only as a spot residual spray and in a manner to preclude contamination.

ANTS, CRICKETS, ROACHES, SILVERFISH, WATERBUGS: Spray heavily in all cracks around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Also, spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and other appliances. Use on other localized areas infested with these pests. Spray known ant trails, and areas around door and window frames, pipe entries, and other means of entry for ants. Repeat all treatments as required.

CARPET BEETLES: Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where insects may be found. Treat crevices, cracks, closets, and infested areas of shelving. Repeat as necessary.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

(Continued from left side panel.)

BROWN DOG TICKS: Thoroughly spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets, and localized areas of floor coverings. Application should be repeated as infestation warrants and as reinfestation occurs. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not treat animal with this formulation.

ACCESSIBLE OR EXPOSED STAGES OF BEETLES (Cigarette, Drugstore, Red Flour, and Saw-Toothed Grain), CADELLES, DERMESTIDS, MOTHS (Indian Meal and Mediterranean Flour), AND WEEVILS: Thoroughly treat walls and floors of infested areas, paying special attention to cracks, crevices, corners, and perimeters. Keep area clean of dirt and accumulations. Burn infested trash.

OUTDOORS

Apply outdoors only to surfaces of buildings, around patios, driveways, sidewalks and foundations. Do not spray vegetation.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, flying MOTHS, and WASPS: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS, CHIGGERS, AND FLEAS: For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in outdoor areas where there is no vegetation, spray infested areas thoroughly. Repeat applications as infestations warrant, and as reinfestations occur.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

GENERAL: Do not contaminate other materials (including foods/drinks/feeds/water) during transport, use, storage, and disposal. Handle any damaged, leaking, or spilled product as directed under "disposal".

STORAGE: Keep in upright, tightly closed original container in a cool, dry, locked area inaccessible to children and away from sources of ignition, heat, degradation, or contamination (including flames, sparks, hot surfaces, sunlight, and other chemicals).

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on-site or at an approved waste facility.

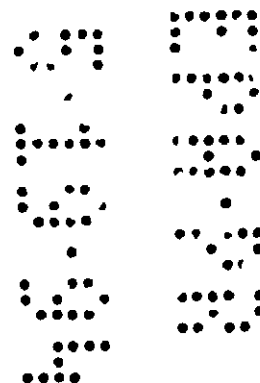
CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local Authorities. Rinsed plastic and paper reinforced plastic containers may also be disposed of by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
