

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Mix thoroughly ONE PART of CO-OP BRAND WARFARIN with 19 PARTS by weight of suitable semi-permanent bait material, such as fresh corn meal, rolled oats, dog food meal, poultry mash, etc. A small amount of bland oil, such as mineral, corn, peanut, or any other edible oil, may be used up to 5% when the bait is so dry it might have a tendency to dust.

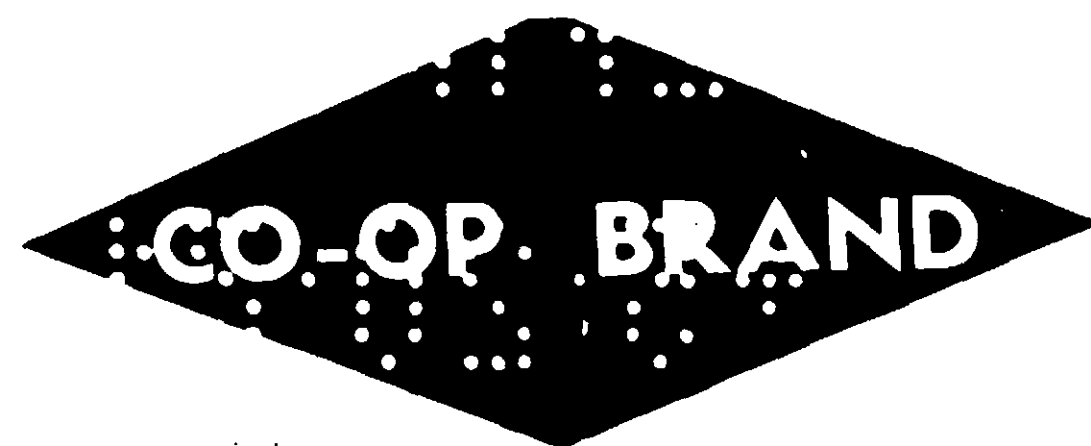
**FOR GROUND MEAT AND FISH BAITS:** Dogs and cats will actively search out the baits of this type. Therefore, baits must be placed so as to positively prevent feeding by these animals.

Place 2 oz. to 1 pound of mixed bait in locations frequented by rats or where rats have been known to feed. Bait should be placed in locations not accessible to children, pets and domestic animals or in tamper-proof bait boxes.

Baits should be examined regularly and replaced before completely eaten. If bait molds, decomposes, or becomes sour, it should be replaced. Where a continuous source of infestation prevails from nearby dumps or fields, permanent bait stations should be used and baits replenished as needed.

**DIRECTIONS: MOUSE CONTROL**  
a) Place tablespoon amounts of bait at 8-12 foot intervals.  
b) An uninterrupted supply of bait should be maintained for at least 15 days.

**DIRECTIONS: RAT CONTROL**  
a) Four ounces of bait per bait location should be minimum amount placed.  
b) An uninterrupted supply of bait should be maintained for approximately 10 days.  
Baiting should continue until lack of feeding is noted. This should be from five to fourteen days.

**CAUTION** <sup>14 P. TYPE</sup>  
**KEEP AWAY FROM HUMANS, DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND PETS.** CO-OP BRAND WARFARIN BAIT contains as its active ingredient an anti-coagulant chemical which if taken by humans, domestic animals or pets, may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and hemorrhage may result. In case baits are accidentally eaten, give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately.

**NOTE FOR PHYSICIAN**  
When a human has been known to have accidentally ingested CO-OP BRAND BAIT, blood transfusions combined with intravenous injections and oral doses of Vitamin K are indicated as in the case of hemorrhage caused by overdose of Dicumarol.
