#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Mix thoroughly ONE PART of CO-OP BRAND WARFARIN with 19 PARTS by weight of suitable semi-permanent bait material, such as fresh corn meal, rolled oats, dog food meal, poultry mash, etc. A small amount of bland oil, such as mineral, corn, peanut, or any other edible oil, may be used up to 5% when the bait is so dry it might have a tendency to dust.


FOR GROUND MEAT AND FISH BAITS: Dogs and cats will actively search out the baits of this type. Therefore, baits must be place so as to positively prevent feeding by these animals.
