

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

- a) Place baits in locations where rats and mice feed, water, or travel.
- b) Bait placements along walls, in corners, and in concealed locations where rats and mice can feed unobserved are desirable.
- c) Contaminated or spoiled baits should be replaced promptly.
- d) Baiting should continue until all signs of feeding have stopped.

2. SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

- a) Where Labeling has directions for using fresh meat or fish as bait, also state, "Dogs and cats will actively search out baits of this type. Therefore, baits must be placed so as to prevent feeding by these animals".
- b) The following statement may be included, but is not mandatory; "Where a continuous source of infestation is present (nearby dumps) permanent bait stations should be established and replenished as needed."
