DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For use in Warehouses, Restaurants and Industrial Institutions, and Small Outdoor Areas.

This formulation is to be used as a fog or spray. The spray particles will be finer than those of a pump spray.

Food should be removed or carefully covered before treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered before treatment or thoroughly cleaned before use.

THERMAL APPLICATIONS INDOORS: For the control of flies, mosquitoes, and other warm-blooded insects in restaurants and industrial institutions. Remove or cover exposed food, handrails, drains, floor coverings, and plants. Shut off ventilating fans and stop rotating equipment. If an insecticide fogger is used, it should be treated by the manufacturer's instructions. Do not use foggers which are occupied or in operation.

Extinguish all fans and pilot lights. Apply as a fog at the rate of 1-1/3 fluid ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space. Direct nozzle of thermal applicator toward the upper corners of the room and along the ceiling. Close off room for at least one-half hour. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

THERMAL APPLICATIONS OUTDOORS: For protection from annoyance from flies, mosquitoes, and other insects in yards, patios, around swimming pools, porches, and other areas, and for use in small area applications.

Hold thermal applicator about 2 feet from plants and shrubbery. Avoid wetting any plants or shrubbery. Apply at the rate of 3/4 gallon per acre. Fog only when there is no breeze or the wind velocity is less than 3 miles per hour. The fog is best generally at dusk when the wind dies down and the air temperature and ground temperature are approximately the same. Under these conditions the fog will linger in the treated area for 1-2 hours. Apply fog while moving away from the treated area. Avoid inhaling the fog. Do not breathe the fog until the fog has dissipated. Repeat applications as necessary.
