DIRECTIONS FOR USE: RATS: Mix thoroughly one part of Rat 42 with 19 parts of a suitable bait material which is available such as corn meal, rolled oats, dogfood, laying mash, stockfood, etc. A small amount of a bland oil such as mineral, corn, peanut or any other edible oil, may be used up to 5%, when the bait is so dry that it might have a tendency to dust. When perishable baits, such as groundmeat, fish, v. getables or similar materials are used, bait placements should be made in the late afternoon and replaced daily with fresh bait. Bait should be examined regularly and replenished before completely eaten. If bait molds, decomposes, or becomes sour, it should be replaced.

MICE: For controlling mice, follow the same general directions as for rats except that the amount of bait replacements should be smaller (1 teaspoon to 1 tablespoonful) and more replacements should be made. Mice are more difficult to control than rats and complete control may take a longer period of baiting.

IMPORTANT: Baiting should be continued as long as evidence of feeding is observed. Except in extremely heavy infestations, this should be from 5 days to 2 weeks. Where a continuous source of infestation is present from nearby dumps or fields, permanent bait stations should be used and baits placed in them as often as necessary.

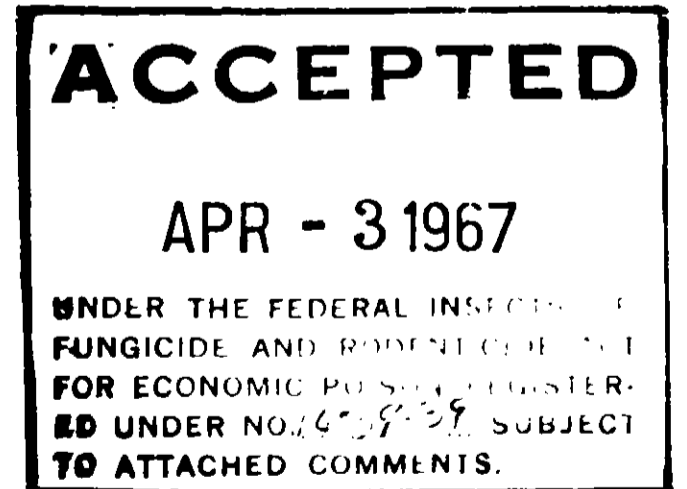
