We have received your revised amended registration form dated July 26, 1996, and found it acceptable.

The Agency has determined that the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), dated April 8, 1996, which was submitted with the above amendment in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable. A copy of this CSF has been placed in our file for this product. All previous versions are obsolete.

If you want to switch to another source at a later date, you must satisfy the generic data requirements that were the basis of the original suspension and request an amendment, including a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), to make the change. Once the Agency has approved that amendment, you can new ~~use~~ the new source.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes and submit one (1) copy to us before you ship your product:

1. In the Precautionary Statements, change "CAUTION" to "WARNING". Also, change "Harmful if swallowed." to "May be fatal if swallowed."
2. On the Left Panel, delete the "Physical Hazards" section since this product is not a liquid, the product that you repack does not have the statement, and you do have not a history of such a hazard with this product.

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If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.


A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
