FIRST AID

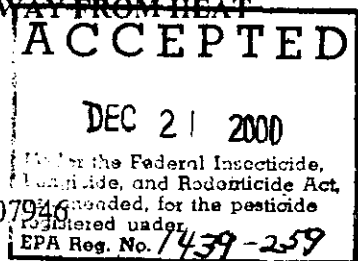
