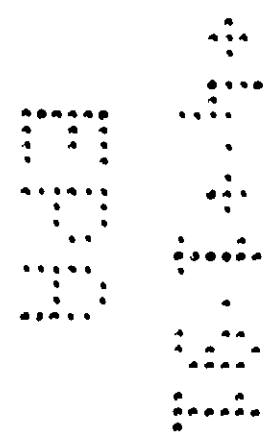

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**THIS IS A CONTACT SPRAY.**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**SPACE SPRAY:** For rapid control of Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Fruit Flies, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Sand Flies, Wasps and Hornets: Close doors and windows and shut off ventilating systems. Apply using a good machine adjusted to deliver a fine mist. Direct spray toward the upper portions of the room to fill the entire area with mist. Using 1 to 2 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space. Vacate the treated area and ventilate before reoccupying. Keep the area closed for ten minutes after treating. Repeat application when reinfestation occurs.

**CONTACTING** as many pests as possible when spraying all treatments should be repeated as necessary.

**ROACHES:** Remove children, pets and fish bowls from quarters, cover foods and any utensils that may be used for foods. Use a **COARSE SPRAY** in the cracks, crevices along baseboards, door and window sills, as well as inaccessible areas behind stoves, refrigerators, around garbage cans, compactors, and utility installations. Apply enough to wet the surface without any run-off of the spray. The insects that are hit by the spray are killed. **DO NOT** spray open floors, carpets, furniture, beds, or bedding.

**ANTS:** Thoroughly spray ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames where these insects may enter the home.

**SPIDERS:** Thoroughly spray baseboards, areas behind shelving, book cases, and storage areas.

**CRICKETS:** Thoroughly spray floors of closets, storage places, and as well as inaccessible areas behind stoves, refrigerators, around garbage cans, compactors, and utility installations.

**FLEAS, BROWN DOG TICKS:** Thoroughly spray infested areas, and the sleeping quarters of household pets. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment.

Repeat as necessary. Do not spray foodstuffs or house plants. Do not treat animals. Treat pets with an EPA approved product registered for pet use.

**HOUSEFLIES, WASPS, MOSQUITOES:** Thoroughly and repeated coarse spraying of selected surfaces such as doors, around windows, and screens, doorsills, and selected areas of porches where insects alight or congregate—and areas frequented by these insects.

**BOX EDLER BUGS & CLOVER MITES:** Areas should be thoroughly sprayed outdoors on porches or side of houses and foundations where box elder bug and clover mites congregate. Also, door sills and window frames should be sprayed where pests enter the home, such as water pipes and similar openings.

**SCORPIONS & EARWIGS:** Thoroughly spray around door sills, window frames or other areas where these pests may enter the premises. Storage areas and other such hiding palaces should also be sprayed.

**CARPET BEETLES CONTROL:** Thoroughly spray infested areas of carpets, localized floors and baseboards, and shelves of closets.
