Active ingredients:

Disodium cyanodithioimidocarbonate
Ethylenediamine
Potassium N-methyldithiocarbamate
Inert ingredients

17.5 percent

APPLICATIONS

Busan 881 was developed for use in industrial microorganism control where a mixed microflora is characteristically encountered. It is used for slime control in paper mills, for treatment of secondary recovery water in the petroleum industry, and for microorganism control in cane sugar mills producing raw sugar and blackstrap molasses. When Busan 881 is used in cane sugar mills, it should be added continuously to the sugar mill grinding systems at the rate of not more than 20 parts of Busan 881 per million parts of cane ground. The Busan 881 should be distributed in such a manner that complete treatment of the mills, troughs, and screens is achieved. Information on these and other applications will be furnished when a detailed description of the problem is provided.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. If swallowed, call a physician immediately. Give patient doses of powdered charcoal immediately or all he can swallow of raw egg whites, milk, gruel, or flour and water. Then induce vomiting with salt, soap, or mustard in warm water. Workmen handling the product should wear rubber gloves and goggles and should avoid contact of the product with clothing or skin. After any exposure, wash promptly and thoroughly with an abrasive soap and cool water and finally with glycerin. In case of persistent irritation of the skin, obtain medical attention. If the product gets into the eyes, flood eyes immediately and thoroughly with cool water for 15 to 30 minutes. See a physician if any irritation persists. Keep the drum closed when not in use. KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.
