

    - c. In the precautionary section, include the statement "wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking and using tobacco.
  - d. Revise the statement "remove and wash contaminated clothing" to "remove adn wash contaminated clothing before reuse."
    - Delete the sentence "Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depressin, and convulsion may be needed".

- g. Revise your "Environmental Hazards" statement to read
