Proposed Amendment

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Separate the Precautionary Statement heading from the First Aid Statements. In addition, the precautionary heading and its statement must be grouped together to read as follows:

Precautionary Statements

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

2. The child signal word "Caution" and the "Keep Out of Reach of Children" statement must be placed under the ingredient statement



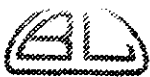
