Harmful or fatal if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes severe skin irritation. If the product gets into the eyes, it causes eye damage. Workmen handling the product should wear rubber gloves and goggles and should avoid contact of the product with clothing, skin, or eyes.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, call a physician immediately. Give patient doses of powdered charcoal immediately or all he can swallow of raw egg whites, milk, gruel, or flour and water. Then induce vomiting with salt, soap, or mustard in warm water. After any skin exposure, wash promptly and thoroughly with an abrasive soap and cool water and finally with glycerin. In case of persistent irritation of the skin, obtain medical attention. If the product gets into the eyes, flood eyes immediately and thoroughly with cool water for 15 to 30 minutes. See a physician immediately.
