To make mold-resistant paper or paperboard, Busan 1253 is used at 0.05 to 0.1 lb/1000 sq ft (0.15 to 0.3 lb/3000 sq ft) of surface. For coated paper or board, Busan 1253 is incorporated in the coating mix prior to application of the coating. For uncoated paper or board, Busan 1253 is dispersed in water, surface-sizing solution, or other solvent and applied to the surface to be protected by means of an applicator roll.
