WSCP 10 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water cooling towers. Control of algae, bacteria, and fungi in the fresh water used in hot growth of bacteria that cause degradation of cutting fluids. Refer to *Broad Spectrum Microbicide Concentrate* for detailed directions applications.

To maintain pools free of visible algae, add a slug dose of 13.5 to 27 fluid ounces of WSCP 10 per 10 000 gal of water after the initial treatment.

Uniform distribution of WSCP 10 throughout the water in the pool is essential for effectiveness. WSCP 10 is compatible with those chemicals normally used in pools, both acid and alkaline pH.
