### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**In case of eye contact,** wash with plenty of soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. **If product gets in the eyes,** flush immediately with copious amounts of clean, cool water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately. **If swallowed,** call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. *Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.*

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

##### WARNING

Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**PROHIBITIONS:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose of in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place. Consult Federal, State, or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.
