### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of eye contact, wash with plenty of soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. If product gets in the eyes, flush immediately with copious amounts of clean, cool water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately. If swallowed, call a physician or Poison Control Center. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.** Rinse mouth with copious amounts of water or milk, and then give 1 or 2 glasses of water or milk to drink. #### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
