STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of skin contact: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. If product gets in the eyes, flush immediately with copious amounts of water. Get medical attention immediately. If **swallowed**, call a physician or Control Center. Drink lots of glasses of water and induce vomiting by sticking back of throat with finger. *Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth if the person is unconscious.*

SEE A PHYSICIAN. Probable mucosa damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against respiratory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

DANGER
