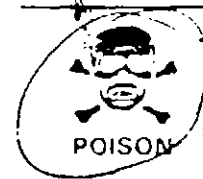

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of skin contact, wash with plenty of soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. DANGER
