The label format has been revised to more closely reflect the requirements of 40 CFR 156.10. Since our current software package does not efficiently handle multiple layouts, we are revising all pesticide product label layouts.

It should be added to the oil as it is being transferred from the shipping container to the storage tank at the rate of 0.3 to 6.0 ft. oz BUSAN 71 per 1000 gal of oil. Addition should be made batchwise where mixing occurs or continuously to the suction side of the transfer pump.
