1. Change "Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds" to "Do not apply directly to water."
2. The directions for use must be expanded. Detailed directions for use may be obtained from the labeling of pesticide products intended for use only by formulators in preparing pesticide for sale to the public provided that:
  - a. There is information readily available to the formulators on the composition, methods of use, applicable restrictions or limitations, and effectiveness of the product for pesticide purposes. This information may be in the form a technical data sheet which accompanies the label. Otherwise, directions must be given on the label for obtaining this information from the company.
