STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of skin contact, wash with plenty of soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. If swallowed, call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.


