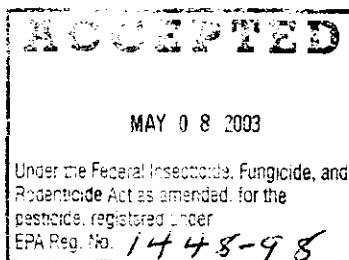
FIRST AID
