DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To preserve water-thinned coatings in their container, Busan 11-M4 should be mixed with other pigments in the pigment grind at concentrations of 1 to 3% based on total weight of the coating. To provide fungal resistance to paint films, Busan 11-M4 is added in the same way at concentrations of 5 to 20% based on total weight of the coating. The exact amount will be determined by the geographical location in which the coating will be exposed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store on pallets off of floor or ground in a covered area. Prevent moisture from penetrating bags. Damaged bags should be placed in a larger container to prevent spread of dust. Product should be used immediately or disposed of as below. **BUSAN 11-M4 DISPOSAL:** Product wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess product is a violation of Federal law.
