**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

B-103-2 is used to inhibit bacterial growth and prevent the degradation of water-based and water emulsifiable cutting fluids and coolants used in metalworking operations. It should be added to a diluted cutting fluid at a rate of 150 to 250 parts per million B-103-2 after final dilution with water. Higher concentrations are needed for growth on the inside walls of the fluid storage tanks, higher concentrations are needed. For this application, that B-103-2 be added to the cutting fluid as prepared to provide a concentration of 150 to 250 parts per million.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL**

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Drums should be opened in well ventilated areas. Leaking drums should be disposed of in accordance with the following instructions.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. If you cannot follow the instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Hazardous Waste representative at your EPA Regional Office for guidance.
