The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

- Label Amendment per PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

1. Revise the Precautionary Statements by including the phrase "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."
2. Delete the second First Aid section immediately following the Precautionary Statements since the previous First Aid section is acceptable. In addition, change the subheading "If Ingested" to "If Swallowed" in the First Aid Statement.



Directions for Use

a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner consistent with its labeling. B-7-2 is used to inhibit the growth of bacteria in metalworking fluids employed as lubricants or coolants in the machining and processing of metals.

It is recommended that B-7-2 be added to the diluted metalworking fluid at a concentration of .01 to .10 percent based on total weight of the metalworking fluid. Where added to the undiluted metalworking fluid, B-7-2 should be added to a concentration which will provide .01 to .10 percent concentration when diluted with water for use.

Treatment of the diluted metalworking fluid should be repeated every four weeks as long as the metalworking fluid is used. More frequent treatment may be required if excessive contamination occurs.
