DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

W-60-10 is used to control bacteria and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial air wash systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slime, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of W-60-10 fluid ounces of W-60-10 per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 8 parts per million, is recommended. Repeat initial

Subsequent slug additions of 0.2 W-60-10 per 1000 parts per million of W-60-10 should be employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the problem. Slug additions should be made in the supply lines to the collection trays of the airwash system.

air-washing systems that maintain effective concentrations of 2.25 to 5.55 fluid ounces of W-60-10 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the problem. Slug additions should be made in the supply lines to the collection trays of the airwash system.

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not stack more than four drums high. Leaking drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a sanitary landfill. Containers should be closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this pesticide should be disposed of at a government approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:
