It is recommended that the diluted metalworking fluid at a concentration of 0.01 to 0.10 percent of the total weight of the metalworking fluid. When used as a metalworking fluid, the concentration which will provide .01 to .10 percent of the total weight of the metalworking fluid for use.

Treatment of the diluted metalworking fluid should be done every 2 to 4 weeks as long as the metalworking fluid is used. Additional treatment is required if excessive contamination occurs.
