It is recommended that B-7-16 be added to the diluted metalworking fluid at a concentration of 0.01 to 0.10 percent of total weight of the metalworking fluid. Where a concentrated metalworking fluid is used, B-7-16 should be added at a concentration which will provide .01 to .10 percent concentration of B-7-16 in the water for use.

Treatment of the diluted metalworking fluid should be continued every 2 to 4 weeks as long as the metalworking fluid is used. More frequent treatment is required if excessive contamination occurs.
