DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. D-33-1 is used to control microorganisms in petroleum secondary-recovery waterfloods on microbiological deposits. D-33-1 is used as a slug dose to provide a concentration of 12 D-33-1 per 1000 gal followed by a continuous addition of D-33-1 employing a chemical-metering pump to maintain a concentration of D-33-1 on total weight of water treated. Both slug addition and continuous addition should be made through gathering lines, or receiving tanks. Addition should stop when the D-33-1 is also used in water-based drilling muds, completion fluids, and based drilling fluids containing starch, gums, sugars, or other solids for purposes D-33-1 is used at a concentration of D-33-1 per 100 barrels of fluid (0.1% to 0.16% by volume).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
