HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING. Technical assistance in applying Busan 1127 for microorganism control as described in the following is available upon request when a description of the problem is provided.

Busan 1127 is a water repellent preservative used to protect wood products (millwork, shingles, structural lumber, logs, and timbers) in above ground service from fungal decay. Before treatment wood should be clean and dry, and operations such as sawing, planing, machining, cutting, and sanding should be completed. Dilute the product by mixing 1 part of Busan 1127 by volume with 4 parts of mineral spirits and apply to wood products by surface treatment (dipping, spraying, or brushing), vacuum treatment, or pressure treatment.
